

Cardkey Procedures, Fall 2000

Most Cory and Soda Hall Instructional labs (and the buildings themselves) will require **access by cardkey** on evenings and weekends. Cardkey operations are administered in 391 Cory and 387 Soda (9am-noon, 1pm-4pm).

The old, blue cardkeys for Cory, Soda and Davis Halls were replaced with new white ones in Jan 2000.

- Students in any EE or CS class can go to either 391 Cory or 387 Soda to get a new, white cardkey. New cardkeys cost \$20 (\$15 refundable). Payment may be cash, or cheque payable to "UC Regents").
- Students in any EE or CS class can go to either 391 Cory or 387 Soda to request access to the EECS Instructional labs. The cardkey will be enabled for access to all labs in Soda, Cory and Davis Halls for which the student is authorized (2-3 days after the request).

Your access to UNIX and NT labs will depend upon the class(es) you are in:

all other CS and EE classes	117, 199 Cory; 271, 273, 275, 277, 330 Soda; other labs as required; The electronics and engineering labs in Cory will always require a cardkey, and cardkey access will be provided only for certain classes.
Soda Hall entrances:	access from outside is via the west entrance (across from Etcheverry Hall, at the 3rd floor) and the east stairwell entrance (on Leroy Ave, at the 4th floor); access to the 2nd floor is via the east stairwell or the elevator access from outside is via 2nd floor Hearst Ave entrances, and the 1st floor outer and inner doors across from Davis Hall
